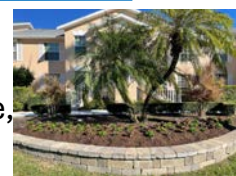
Bike Storage Reminder

Over the summer, one of the key goals of the shed project was to make storing and removing bikes much easier for everyone. As a reminder, per our community Rules & Regulations, bikes **may not** be stored outside under carports or placed next to the sheds. All bicycles must be kept **inside** the sheds when not in use. Thank you for helping us keep the community neat, safe, and consistent with our guidelines.

Bulk Removal Procedures

Please remember that Wiggins follows a specific process for bulk item removal. In the Lakes buildings (the long buildings), you must schedule a pickup directly with Collier County/Waste Management at **239-252-2380** to dispose of large items. Large items should **not** be placed in the dumpster or stored in the dumpster enclosure at any time. Your cooperation helps keep our shared spaces clean and accessible for everyone.”
