- **GANODERMA AGAIN** - Unfortunately we have another palm infected with Ganoderma. You may recall a few years ago we had to remove several palms. Ganoderma is a fungus that attacks palms and causes internal decay and death within 1-3 years. It manifests as mushroom-like conks on the lower part of the trunk. Sadly, there is no cure; palms must be removed to prevent spread. This infected palm is by unit 691 and will be removed.
- **IRRIGATION ISSUES** – As you walk around, if you notice any issues with our irrigation system (e.g. misaimed sprinkler, or an area not being watered) please send a **Message to the Manager**. Please do not try to fix anything yourself. The Leo Jr crew noticed that our Zone 4 was drying out and they saw that the control valve was turned off which put our new plantings in jeopardy. We can use everyone’s help with this.
