- SHEDS In the June 4 Board Meeting, the contract to repair the sheds was awarded to Excellent Solutions. Derek will meet with the contractor on Monday to set a schedule. We will begin with the ones most in need. Derek will be communicating the details with owners in email blasts. We expect work to begin soon, so please read all communications. If you haven't already taken care of this, PLEASE empty your shed and remove the lock. If your shed is not emptied, we will have to cut off the lock and remove the items; we are NOT responsible for your property. If you have a car blocking your shed, you should also move it to avoid any damage. Your Homewatch person could also be of help in this. Call Derek with any questions.
- HOMEWATCH It is now hurricane season it is essential you have a Homewatch person. You should have someone here you can reach out to when you are away. Please get someone in place!
- PAINTING SCHEDULE Painting is moving along smoothly. Check this schedule. IMPORTANT please read the notice posted on your building with further details. To protect your property, remove car from driveway, outside items, and open hurricane shutters. Close windows and doors tightly!

June 14 is Flag Day

This celebrates the adoption of the flag by the 2<sup>nd</sup> Continental Congress, June 14, 1777. Pres. Woodrow Wilson made it a holiday in 1916.

The 13 stripes represent the original thirteen colonies.

The 50 stars represent the fifty states. The colors also have meaning. Red signifies VALOR, white signifies PURITY, and blue signifies PERSEVERANCE. Our American flag is also referred to as Old Glory, or The Stars and Stripes.
